Gentleman and Mary his Wife of the one part and Edward Steppen Bird
of the City of Philadelphia in the State of Pennsylvania Gentleman of the
other part Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of Ten
thousand Dollars lawful Money of the United States to the said John M.
Kim and Mary his Wife well and truly paid by the said Edward
Steppen Bird at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents
the Recy't whereof the said John M. Kim and Mary his Wife do
hereby acknowledge and confess themselves to be therewith fully satis-
fied contented and paid and thereof and therefrom and of and from every
part and parcel thereof do release a quit and for ever discharge the said
Edward Steppen Bird his Heirs Executors and Administrators by these
presents the said John M. Kim and Mary his Wife have granted bargained
and sold aliened enfeoffed conveyed and made over and by these presents
do grant bargain and sell alien enfeoff convey and make over unto the
said Edward Steppen Bird his Heirs and Assigns All that piece of
Parcel of Ground Situate and lying in the City of Philadelphia aforesaid
which is contained within the metes and bounds courses and distances
following that is to say Beginning for the same on the West side of
Eleventh Street at the distance of one hundred Feet Northwesterly from the
North West Corner of Spruce and Eleventh Streets and running thence North-
erly bounding on Eleventh Street one hundred and fifty feet to Lot number
Eight hundred and ninety nine thence Westerly bounding on that lot and
parallel with Spruce Street one hundred and eighty eight feet to an Alley
twenty feet wide thence Southerly bounding on the said Alley and parallel
with Eleventh Street one hundred and fifty feet and thence Easterly by a
straight line one hundred and eighty eight feet to the place of beginning
the same comprising the Northernmost six of Ten Lots of Ground which
were heretofore conveyed by the Supreme Executive Council of the Common-
wealth of Pennsylvania to the said John M. Kim his Heirs and Assigns in fee
by Deed Poll under the hand of William Moore Vice President of the said
Council and Seal of the State bearing date on or about the Ninth Day of
November in the Year of our Lord One thousand seven hundred and eighty one

Book N. 1 page 107) Together with all and singular the Rights Liberties
Privileges Appurtenances and Advantages to the said described piece or
Parcel of Ground belonging or in anywise appertaining and the Reversion
and Reversions Remainder and Remainders Rents Issues and Profits thereof
and of every part and parcel thereof and also all the Estate Right Title

Interest Use Trust Possession Property Claim and Demand whatsoever both at Law and in Equity of the said John M. Kim and Mary his Wife and each of them of in to and out of the same To have and to hold the piece or parcel of Ground and Premises above described and hereby intituled to be conveyed with the appurtenances unto the said Edward Steyphen Burd his Heirs and Assigns to the only proper Use and Behoof of the said Edward Steyphen Burd his Heirs and Assigns for ever and to and for none other Use Intent or Purpose whatsoever And the said John M. Kim for himself his Heirs Executors and Administrators doth hereby Covenant and Agree to and with the said Edward Steyphen Burd his Heirs and Assigns that the said John M. Kim and his Heirs shall and will at any time hereafter do and execute acknowledge and deliver or cause and procure to be done made executed acknowledged and delivered all such further and other acts Deeds assurances and Conveyances in the Law as shall or may be reasonably advised or devised and required by the said Edward Steyphen Burd his Heirs or Assigns or his or their Counsel for the better and more perfectly granting releasing and assuring unto the said Edward Steyphen Burd his Heirs and Assigns for ever all such Estate and Interest as the said John M. Kim now has or at any time heretofore had in the Ground and Premises above described and hereby mentioned to be conveyed according to the purport true intent and meaning of these presents In Witness whereof the said John M. Kim and Mary his Wife have hereunto subscribed their names and affixed the seals on the Day and Year first above written —
